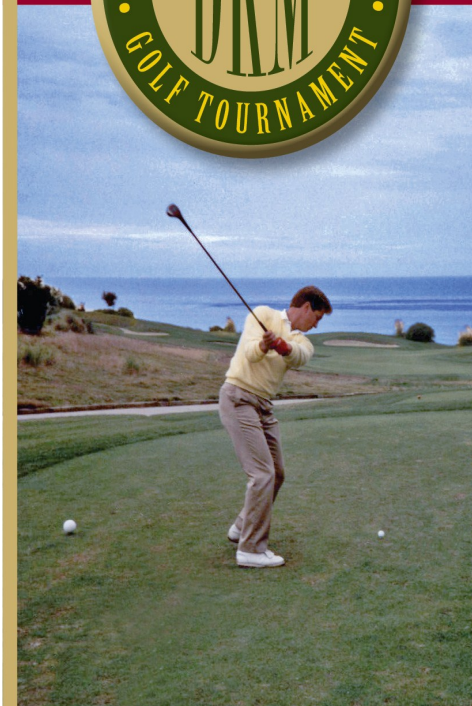

## Kiebach Known as Sportsman, Businessman, Family Man



Dave Kiebach was a competitor in sports and in business. He played golf and basketball, rode horseback, hunted, fished, swam and boated.

He was longtime friend and partner with Mark Sell in founding and building MD Logistics, Inc. in 1996, and establishing MD Express and MD Packaging subsequently. In addition, he and Sell cemented a strategic partnership with SEKO Worldwide in 2002. In 2006, MDL was named 13th Fastest-Growing private company in Central Indiana by the Indianapolis Business Journal, based on percentage growth in revenue over a three-year period.

Kiebach's global logistics experience had been developed between 1982 and 1993 with CF Airfreight (Indianapolis and Los Angeles), TNT Express (Los Angeles), American Airlines (Los Angeles), and LEP International (Los Angeles and Indianapolis).

Kiebach earned bachelor of science degrees in journalism and marketing from Ball State University in 1982.

Most of all Kiebach was a family man, known to dote on his wife Diana and two children, their daughter MacKenzie, and son, Sean.

Kiebach died unexpectedly on November 5, 2007, of massive coronary failure.
